Responsibilities

- Through modeling and ongoing guidance, support coaches in instructional technique, practice and game management, improving player's physical and mental skills, and Coordinate Boys Traveling Teams
- Assist coaches in the design and implementation of practice plans (weeknights)

The coordinator must have playing and coaching experience with boys' Baseball. Coordinator may also have the opportunity to take on additional jobs in the organization.
